The dinner was hosted by the president of the Path to Peace Foundation, **His Excellency Archbishop Francis Chullikatt, Apostolic Nuncio and Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations**, who presented the 2012 Path to Peace Award to His Excellency **János Áder, President of Hungary** for championing Hungary's pro-personhood constitution

and the institution of family. President Áder is the first president elected under Hungary's new national constitution, which took effect on January 1, 2012. The constitution's opening line, "God bless the Hungarians," marks a dramatic departure from the nation's previous Soviet-era style of constitution, as well as the more secular constitutions of Hungary's European neighbors.
