

# AMERICAN DELEGATION OF SAVOY ORDERS

## <u>Ninth Annual St. Lazarus Mass and Dinner – March 12, 2014</u> Celebrating the Beatification of Venerable Maria Cristina of Savoy

On March 12, 2014, the Knights and Dames of the American Delegation of Savoy Orders of the Royal House of Savoy and their guests participated in the ninth annual St. Lazarus Mass at the University Church of St. Joseph in New York City, commemorating the recent Beatification of the Venerable Maria Cristina of Savoy in Naples, on January 25. Queen Maria Cristina, (1812-36),whose husband ruled the largest of the Italian kingdoms before national unification, was born a Savoy princess, the daughter of King Victor Emmanuel I of Sardinia and Archduchess Maria

Teresa of Austria-Este. In 1832 she married the future King Ferdinand II of the Two Sicilies. The queen died following the birth of their only child, King Francesco II, who became the last King of the Two Sicilies in 1859 and reigned until he was deposed in 1861 by the forces for Italian unification under the Royal House of Savoy.

Maria Cristina had always been a devout Catholic and she came to rely on her faith





ever more in times of trial. Her commitment to God and the Church, serene detachment and beautiful appearance caused many people to see her as an almost angelic figure and even then many began to refer to her as a saint. Her pious reputation was such that there was great support for it and in 1872 Pope Pius IX recognized her status as a Servant of God. The cause continued to progress and on May 6, 1937, Pope Pius XI recognized the Queen as Venerable Servant of God. May 3, 2013, His Holiness Pope Francis recognized a miracle attributed to her intercession, opening for the way

beatification on January 25, 2014, the last stage prior to canonization as a saint.

Pope Francis described Queen Maria Cristina as a "woman of deep spirituality and great humility." "She was able to bear the suffering of her people, becoming a true mother of the poor," he added. "Her extraordinary example of charity shows that the good life of the Gospel is possible in every environment and social status."

the recent deaths of Delegation member Comm. John W. Cross III, Dama di Comm. Larissa Van Duser's mother and Cav. Avv. Richard Miller's mother. During the homily, Cav. Msgr. McNamara spoke about the evening's religious service of remembrance, commemorating the beatification of Queen Cristina of Savoy and

her short, saintly life and he reflected on her life of undoubted wisdom in the art and the energy of being saintly, at so young an age. Queen Maria Cristina was always adored because of the care and compassion she showed toward her adopted country and because of how she endured her less than ideal life, with patience and pious devotion.

The Mass was followed by a convivial dinner nearby at Gradisca Restaurant. The honored guest for the dinner

was His Excellency Archbishop Francis Chullikatt, Apostolic Nuncio and Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations.




