The foundation provides scholarships for vocal students in affiliation the National Italian American with Foundation and has given more than 540 scholarships over the years. Performers came from around the world - one from St. Petersburg, Russia, and another from Johannesburg, South Africa. This year's show was themed to the '60s with tenor James Valente, a former scholarship recipient, who has sung at the Metropolitan Opera in New York, the People's Tenor" Michael Amante, alongside a roster of past international vocal grand winners and the 2014 winners. Maestro Jeff Domoto conducted the 32-piece orchestra before an audience of thousands.
