PROTOCOLS

Dress Code and Comportment

Members of the Guardia d'Onore should dress and comport themselves while standing guard in the Pantheon under the following guidelines:

-Dark Suits, white or at most light blue shirt, no other colors, least of all black, no t-shirts, not even modestly covered by the cape.

-Black or Blue shoes, absolutely no sneakers.

-Please do not talk to the tourists or even our colleagues and please do not pose for photographs. The Guard must always stand at attention. Please limit your movements as much as possible. Please do not walk around the Pantheon. If you must use the rest room or take a short break, please exit the Pantheon in a dignified manner. Please make a note of this in the register. As a role model to the tourist, we must always show respect to the Sovereigns and also those Guards who are standing guard.

-At the end of the service, the register of signatures must be placed in the appropriate wooden container and must not be left unattended.

-The guard duty is done at the Royal Tombs, not at the register and therefore no explanations must be provided to the visitors.

-The Honor Guard Cape is not mandatory. However, if worn, it must be worn while on guard duty at the Pantheon or other sites where the Monarchs are buried. The Cape must not be worn anywhere else without the expressed permission of the President which will be conveyed by the Delegate.
